**Items of safety & security:** Bayview Transit Mix has moved the catwalk back onto City property next to West apron fence. Could be an issue with Homeland Security.

## **Infrastructure/Improvements:**

Avigation easements still underway, some issues due to land owner transfers. Land owners still need to sign easement documents.

2012 drainage phase II on hold due to lack of matching funds from Connect Oregon. Jack Bland reports that Jack Cridder spoke to Neal Wallace about there may still be a possibility of getting some Connect Oregon funds or maybe from another source. Neal Wallace not at meeting to comment.

**Commercial Operations:** Word has it that Jim's Bi-Plane Rides is planning to return this summer.

Committee Member Reports: Black loaner car is marginal and maybe INOP.

**For the Good of the Order:** John Overholser from the Port of Astoria reports that Camp Rilea will be flying drones over the Camp as part of their training. Drone flights will be limited to 400' altitude, no night operations and to overflights to be kept with the Camp boundaries. Camp Rilea must assure that the see and be seen concept is maintained and must follow VFR. Radio monitoring on Astoria's frequency of 122.8 will be maintained during flights. John Overholser recommended to Camp Rilea that they also monitor Seaside's frequency of 122.9. Notams will be issued/posted advising of such operations at Camp Rilea.

Camp Rilea to build 14 windmills at a height of 206'each to generate electricity for the self-sufficiency of the Camp. Fuel truck from the Port still on the table and available.
